#### **ADOPT - A -HIGHWAY COMMITTEE**

The Adopt a Highway Chairperson does not have a standing committee. We do have a list of members who indicate that they may be willing to help cleanup the assigned section of highway. Friendship Force's section of highway 12 is cleaned twice a year, Spring and Fall.

The chairperson selects the dates, notifies the membership via the F.F. monthly news letter about the date, time, meeting location and asks for volunteers. If not enough volunteers, he/she calls members that are on the interest list. He/she should have enough garbage bags and safety vests on hand for the cleanup. These items can be gotten from the Dane County Highway Department.

After the cleanup the chairman notifies Dane County Highway Department as to the date, location and number of bags filled. A report is then submitted for the F.F. monthly news letter.
